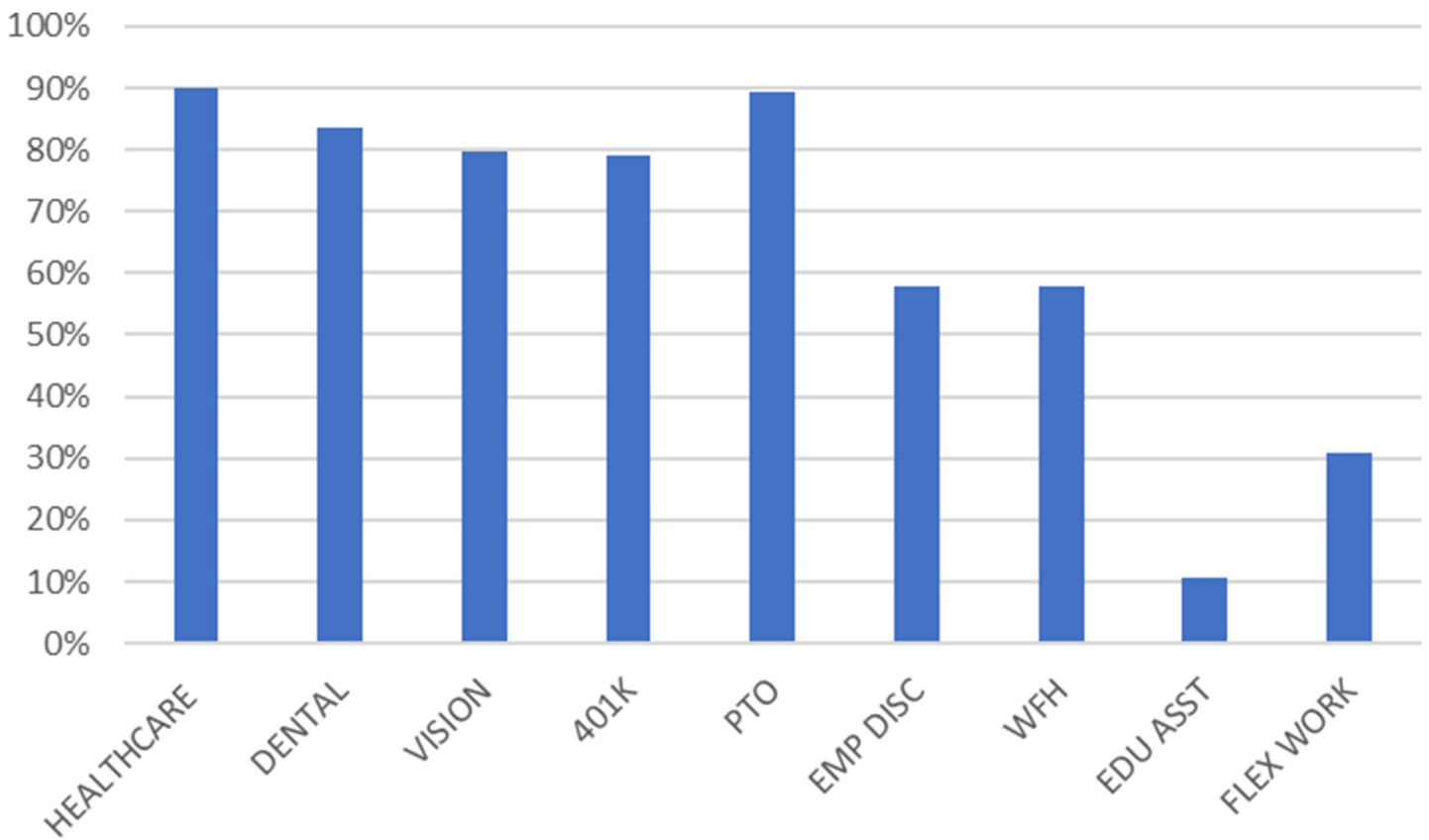

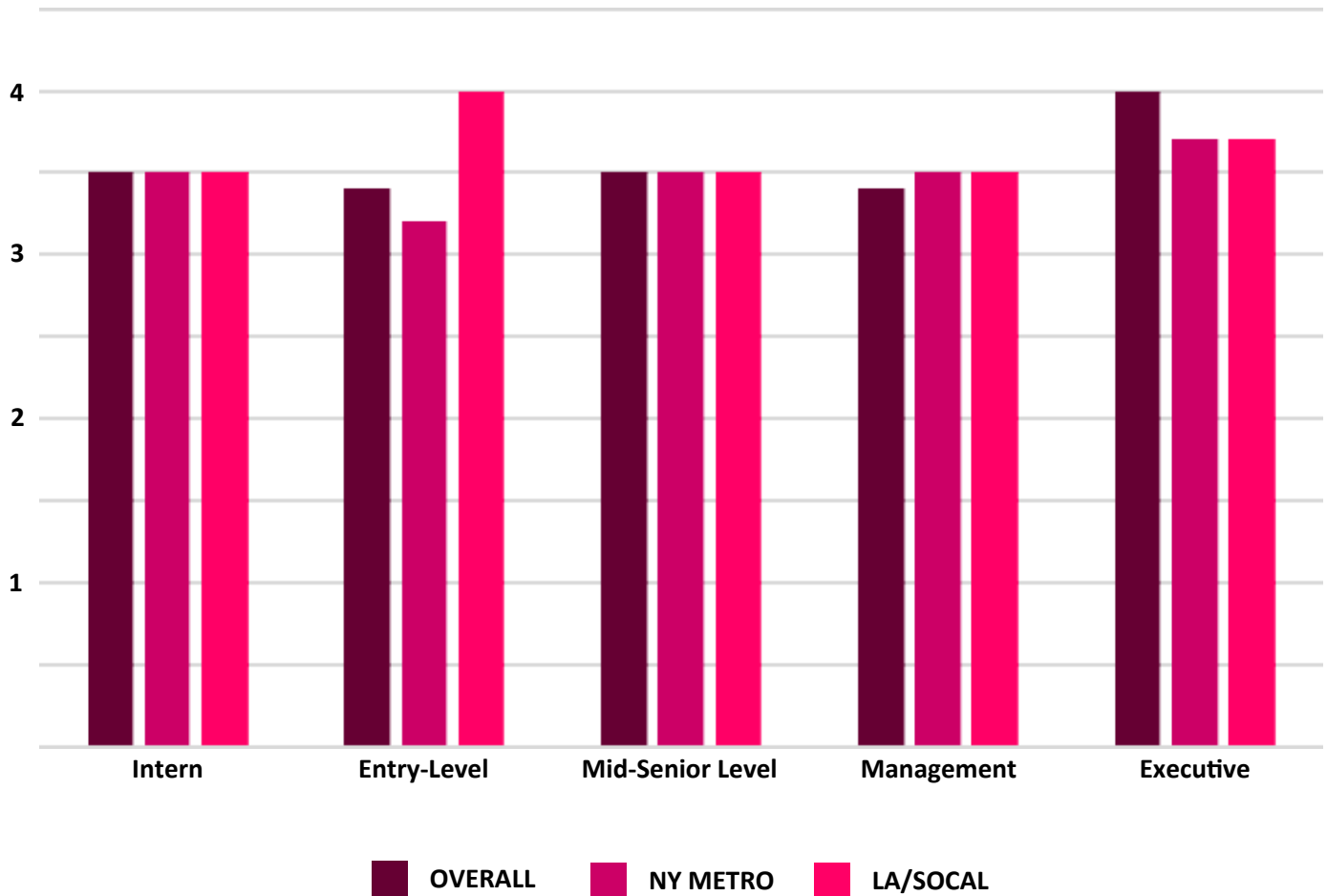

METHODOLOGY STATEMENT

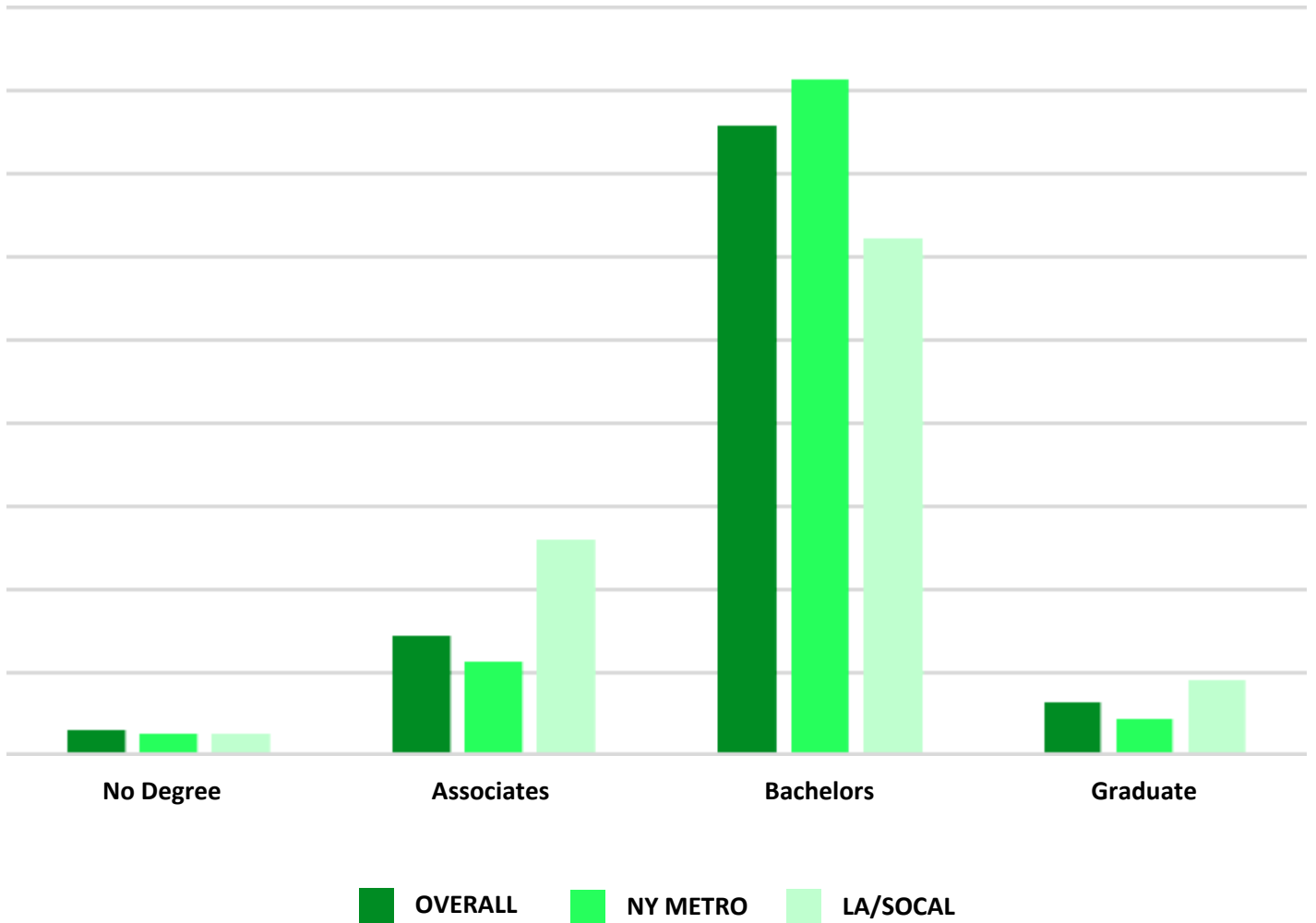

APPAREL DESIGNER AVERAGE EMPLOYER RATING



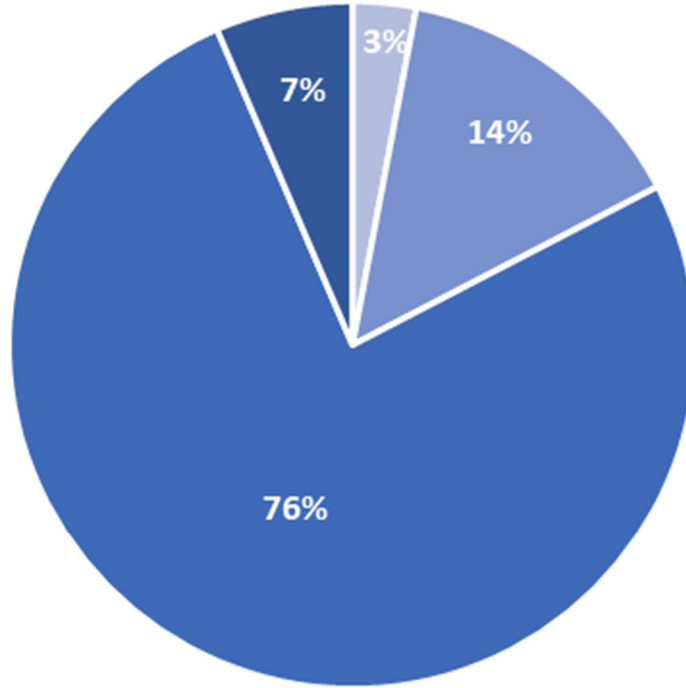
Note: We asked apparel designers to rate their current employers on a 5-star scale to get a good idea as to their general job satisfaction.

APPAREL DESIGNER EDUCATION LEVELS BY REGION



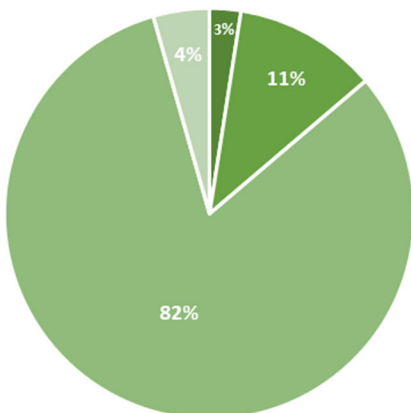
Note: We asked apparel designers about their education and not the education requirements of the jobs they hold.

APPAREL DESIGNER EDUCATION LEVELS - NATIONAL



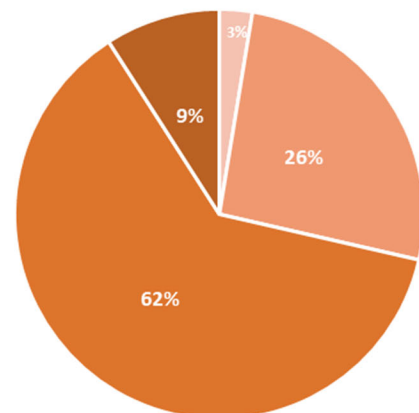
